Mary McRae has taken classical piano lessons from Janet D. Gray since 2002. She was in band at Tishomingo Middle School from 2005 to 2008, and played the clarinet. She also taught herself guitar and voice, as well as writing many songs. She was in the Tishomingo County High School Chorus from 2008-2009. Mary has been on the All-A's honor roll since the first grade. She placed third at the local science fair, first place at the regional science fair, and fifth at the state science fair in 2011. She received the American Physiological Award, the U.S. Army for Excellence in Science Award, and the Exceptional Genius Award for her project. Mary has been a T.C.H.S. Varsity Cheerleader for four years, as well as an MHSAA Cheerleading State Champion in 2010. She is an active member of the T.C.H.S. Student council, Beta Club, Anchor Club, Crown Club, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, Yearbook Staff, and Bravada Drama Team. She has been class Vice-President during her freshman, sophomore, and junior years, and she is Student Council President-Elect this year. She served as a junior page for Senator J.P. Wilemon during March of her sophomore year, and she was elected onto the T.C.H.S. homecoming court in 2010. Mary was Student of the Month in September 2008. She plans on attending Vanderbilt University in Nashville, Tennessee, where she will major in pre-medicine before attending medical school.

John O'Bannon Baxter is the son of Anne Baxter of Hattiesburg. He is a student of Dr. Laura Broughton, with whom he has studied piano for eight and a half years. His piano achievements include nine years of participation in the Mississippi Federation of Music Clubs Junior Festival for District III and eight years of participation in the MMTA Pre-College State Special Recognition Recitals and Finals. With his ensemble partner, he has won first place in their ensemble division the past two years. He has also won scholarships to attend the summer Music Camp at Mississippi College. Last year, John won both 1st and 2nd place awards in different categories for his original compositions in the Junior Composers Contest of the Mississippi Federation of Music Clubs.

John is currently a sophomore at Oak Grove High School, where he is a member of the Warrior football team. He is also on the Robotics Team and a performer with CenterStage, a competitive Show Choir team. He is a member of Mu Alpha Theta mathematics honor society and the Beta Club. He will begin work on a Distinguished Scholar Project next year in which he will rescore a film. He has been on the All-A Honor Roll throughout his years at Oak Grove.

Besides composing and performing music, John enjoys acting and stage performance. He has been in several Hattiesburg Civic Light Opera productions, and he is presently working as the stage tech for the Oak Grove Drama Team. John recently learned that he was chosen to attend the 2011 session of the Mississippi Governor's School. A Duke TIP participant, John won a state recognition medal for his performance on the ACT. He is also a Davidson Scholar. John is a member of River of Life Church. On Sunday evenings, he volunteers his time to play the piano for the residents of Emeritus Senior Living facility.

Mary Marino, an honor student with Eagle Home Schools, has studied classical piano with Janet D. Gray for nine years, participating successfully in all available local, district and national piano events. In 2011 she earned her large Gold Cup at Piano Festival, sponsored by Mississippi Federation of Music Clubs. She was chosen twice to play at the Link Center program featuring outstanding Northeast Mississippi Piano students. This spring she will complete her ninth year of National membership (10 piece program) for the American College of Musicians. Next year, she plans to earn her High School Diploma in Piano and present a senior recital. Together with another student, she has presented a program of music for Corinth Music Clubs.

Mary is a member of Oakland Baptist Church, where she is active in Youth Choir and puppet Ministry; she also serves in areas of nursery, Library and Vacation Bible School.
