MMTA's 2024 State Conference will be held at Belhaven University on November 1-2, 2024, featuring our:

- <u>Conference Clinician</u> **Leila Viss** is a nationally-recognized expert in the pedagogy of creativity and composition at the piano.
- Guest Artists The Patterson/Sutton Duo brings their rich cello and guitar repertoire to international audiences, with "beguiling sound" and "wit and imagination."
- IMTF Luncheon Speaker and Piano Judge for the Pre-College Piano Concerto Competitions Dr. Kevin Chance, associate professor of piano at the University of Alabama, performs nationally and internationally while maintaining an award-winning studio of pre-college students.
- <u>Commissioned Composer</u> **Dr. Andy Sauerwein**, professor of music at Belhaven University, holds advanced degrees in composition from Duke University and the University of Oregon.

A piano master class will be presented by Guest Clinician Leila Viss on Friday afternoon. A strings master class will be given by the Guest Artists, the Patterson/Sutton Duo on Saturday morning. On Friday of the Conference, performances will include the Guest Artist Recital and the New Faculty Recital, as well as the New Music Recital, debuting MMTA's Commissioned Composition and

compositions by winners of MTNA's Composition Competitions. The Gold Medal Winners Recital will take place on Saturday morning.

At our August meeting I will give a full financial recap of the 2023-24 fiscal year along with the proposed budget for the 2024-25 fiscal year. 
